There are currently:

- *380+ Ronald McDonald Houses which provide private bedrooms, home cooked meals and a support staff for families living 50+ miles from the hospital.
- *265+ Ronald McDonald Family Rooms which is a space inside hospitals for caretakers to rest and recharge.
- *40 Ronald McDonald Care Mobiles bringing medical, dental and health care services to under-served communities.
- *260+ Chapters help families access medical care for their children and offer family support services.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

Millions of McDonald's customers drop change in donation boxes at thousands of restaurants around the world, with these coins helping hundreds of thousands of families.
